
RESEARCH AND RESULTS DISSEMINATION TO THE ECONOMIC WORLD

Innovative research activities and result dissemination are central to the University's policies.

The Research Promotion department is the main contact for exchanges between the laboratories and companies leading to research and transfer operations. Its helps research laboratories transfer their results to industrial and commercial activities. Along with the Industrial and Commercial Activity Department (SAIC), it is responsible for all the legal and financial aspects of the collaboration between laboratories and the socio-economic environment.

The Burgundy – Franche-Comté Region lies at the heart of Europe. Located in the East of France, it is equally distant from Alsace, Rhône-Alpes, Auvergne, Strasbourg, and Lyon. Exchange programs

The University of Franche-Comté is actively involved in the development of exchange programs allowing inbound and outbound mobility across all continents.

These programs give students the opportunity to expand their horizons and experiences while practicing one or more foreign languages and taking courses for credits. Those credits are transferrable to their home university. All students who have completed 60 ECTS (or 1 French academic year) at the university may apply to participate in those exchange programs.

Every fall, the International Relations & Francophony Office organizes several information sessions in our various schools to present all available exchange programs and to provide all necessary information on study-abroad programs.
